People are being deported on a daily basis. The highly praised "Willkommenskultur" in Germany is being substituted by inhumane and cynical migration- and deportation-policies. Refugees are criminalized, left to die on the refugee routes and asylum seekers are being deported. But there is resistance to these practices.

The so called "Bürger*innenAsyl" (citizen asylum) can be seen as a solidary answer to inhumane deportations. Through civil disobedience, offering private homes, parts of the civil society fight against the forcedly return of refugees into detention, persecution or war. The "Bürger*innenAsyl" is therefore a symbolic and practical opposition to the prevalent politics of isolation and deportation against asylum seekers.

We, NoLager and Solidarity City Osnabrück, invited the **initiative Bürger*innenAsyl Wendland/Altmark**. They live solidarity and organize safe spaces for people who are under threat of deportation.
