## **Banyamulenge Persecution**

### • Banyamulenge not "real Congolese" versus "native"

- Citizenship stripped 1981
- Decision to expel Banyamulenge 1995-96
- Targeted massacres (1990S)
  - Across DRC: 1996-1998
  - Gatumba/Burundi: 2004
- Rebellions & Insurgencies

- 2017 to the present
  - 1500 people killed (LNGOs report: 06/2020)
  - $\approx$  400 villages destroyed
  - $\approx$  400,000 cattle looted
  - $\approx$  35 health facilities
  - ≈ 131 schools facilities destroyed
  - Regular attacks & State of besiegement in *Hauts Plateaux/*South Kivu
- Victims of hate speech

# **Banyamulenge in Burundi**

- Aug 2004 Gatumba Massacre: Banyamulenge were deliberately targeted by militias;
- Current regime has limited information - knowledge on the Banyamulenge history
- Rwanda Burundi confrontation: Banyamulenge are likely perceived by Burundi security services as Tutsi (sign of mistrust)

- President <u>Evariste</u> <u>Ndayishimiye</u> contemptibly linked the Banyamulenge to Rwanda (Aug 2022). He claimed "We never heard of the Banyamulenge before 1996. We even know that they don't have a traditional chiefdom. They just come together to form an ethnic group..."
- There have been many incidents of Banyamulenge arrested across Burundi territory (Before 2021).

### **Banyamulenge in Rwanda**

- <u>Gen James Kabarebe</u> (2002) compared the Banyamulenge as people of "Mont Kigali"
- <u>Attack on Congolese refugees in</u> <u>Rwanda (Feb 2018)</u>
- "Kagame Hails Tshisekedi..." over stabilizing Eastern DRC (<u>KTPress, 30</u> Jan 2020)
- During #SaveMulenge campaign (dec 2019), Kagame argued "Minembwe problems involve different groups from different countries, so each country should raise its concerns..." as a path to stop the killings.
- 2017-2021, Rwanda government kept silent when Banyamulenge being destroyed.
- 2019-2021: Excellent relations between Tshisekedi & Kagame

- <u>Rwema Gendarme</u>, a traditional & customary chief was kidnaped Uganda-Rwanda border (08/04/2015)
- Sam Gahungu, a closer friend to Rwema Gendarme was kidnapped in Kampala (15/05/2015)
- Assassination of Danny in Rwanda, hanged on crossbar at a local pitch (08/03/2021)
- Assassination of the prominent Banyamulenge Human Rights activist, <u>Me Bukuru Ntwari</u> in Kigali (02/06/2021);
- Museveni found dead on 18<sup>th</sup> February 2022; his dead body thrown near Lake Kivu;
- Pressure (targeting youth) asked to adhere to M23

# Banyamulenge in Kenya & Uganda

- Both countries shelter a large number of Banyamulenge refugees.
- Their decisions motivated by skepticism to flee to Rwanda or Burundi
- Ordinary Ugandans and Kenyans had limited information about the Banyamulenge;
- Many wish to relocate to safe countries (US, Canada, Europe, Australia...)

- Tensions between resettlement and community protection (back in DRC);
- Some young people (men) have decided to go back in Minembwe to protect their relatives (2019-2021);
- Pee-pressure influences decisions to return;
- There is a growing propaganda and pressure to convince the youth to join M23 (out of despair)

# What to learn?

- The Banyamulenge are likely unwanted (discriminated against) across the African Great Lakes region;
- Some contexts do offer the possibility to speak up, until one has an opportunity to move;
- In a such complex situation, one tries every option which is available to him or her;
- Tensions between community safety and individual development.
- Parents impoverished and its implications on children (youth) education and schooling;
- The future of the community is somehow UNCERTAIN!
